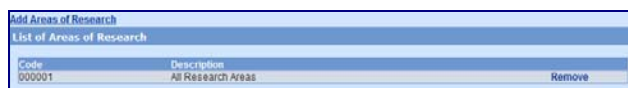


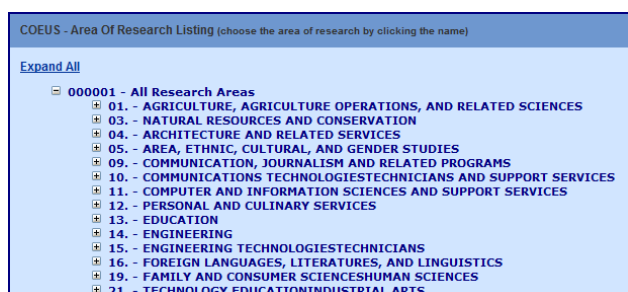
1. Click on the **Areas of Research** link.



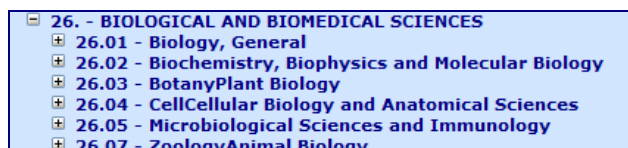
The **Areas of Research** screen displays:



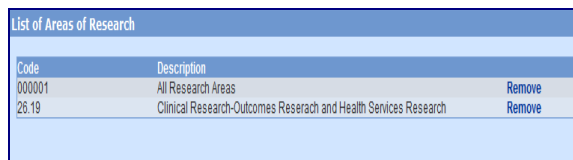
2. Click on the **Add Areas of Research** link. A listing of all research areas displays:



3. Click on the “+” sign next to the research area to expand the listing – this will go away as the display will be fixed in the open position.



4. Choose the appropriate area of research. The results display on the screen: The user should choose as many as may apply to the research



5. Add any additional areas of research.

Note: The entries made in this field are frequently used to direct the protocol to appropriate committees or for reporting. Entries in this field ***are required*** to provide simultaneous submission via electronic routing to the **Cancer Center’s Protocol Review Committee** and in some instances the appropriate **Yale IRB**. Critical entries include the following:
