Yale Divinity School and the Institute of Sacred Music, in cooperation with Berkeley Divinity School, will offer an exciting series of weeklong courses in a variety of fields, including biblical studies, worship, music, interfaith dialogue, pastoral care, art, and ministry.

Three sessions are planned in New Haven during the weeks of June 5-9, June 12-16, and June 19-23, and will coincide with the city's annual International Festival of Arts & Ideas. Most courses will meet for two and one-half hours each day over five days, either in the morning or afternoon.

## SCHOLARSHIPS ESTABLISHED AND GROWING

### Sam S. and Ima Lou Langley Scholarship

The Sam S. and Ima Lou Langley Scholarship was established by Sam Langley '52 B.D. both in memory of his wife Ima Lou and in recognition of his many years of ministry. The scholarship will be awarded annually to a YDS student(s) with a preference for those preparing for ministry either in the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) or in the United Church of Christ. Rev. Langley retired from First Christian Church in Columbia, MO.

### Ruth Lister Scholarship

The Ruth Lister Scholarship was established by a gift from her estate. Dr. Lister '49 B.D. had expressed the desire that the scholarship be awarded annually with a preference for women, especially those with an interest in Christian education and mission. Dr. Lister retired as Associate professor of Education at Slippery Rock State University in Pennsylvania in 1979. She had a lifelong affiliation with the American Baptist Church and was actively involved in developing instructional materials in Christian Education for the Baptist and various other denominations. At the time she attended YDS she was one of six women students in her class.

### Nickerson Merit Scholarships

The William and Lucille Nickerson Scholarship Fund, originally established in 1982 received significant additional gifts this year from their estate. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of merit and need to fulltime students at the Divinity School.
