FUNDING

\$100,000 for one year. (Total: \$100,000)

NOMINATION LIMITATION

Yale may submit letters of intent from three (3) nominees.

PURPOSE

The Breast Cancer Alliance invites physician scientists and research scientists whose primary focus is breast cancer to apply for an Exceptional Project Grant. This award recognizes creative, unique and innovative research and is open to applicants at institutions within a 200 mile radius of Greenwich, Connecticut.

ELIGIBILITY

- Candidates are eligible at any stage of their careers.
- The proposed research project must be directly related to the field of breast cancer.
- Areas of relevant research may include, but are not limited to:
diagnosis, etiology, immunology, genetics, therapies, prevention, and clinical studies.

INTERNAL COMPETITION PROCEDURES

For this internal competition, please follow the instructions below. These instructions are identical to the letter of intent instructions outlined by the Breast Cancer Alliance.

- Provide a one-page, 10 pt, single-spaced Letter of Intent (LOI) and a separate CV.
 - The LOI must include the applicant's name, job title, and institution at the top of the page, and the applicant's contact information.
 - The document should state the project title and hypotheses, outline the research aim(s) and methods, and include a brief discussion of the project's potential impact.
 - The CV can be in the NIH biosketch format.
