FUNDING

- \$50,000 for 1 year, renewable annually for 2 additional years with satisfactory progress. (\$150,000)
Funds can be used per year as follows: salary expense up to \$35,000 including fringe benefits; up to 8% for indirect costs (\$3,704); and the remainder for supplies and/or equipment (\$11,296).

NOMINATION LIMITATION

Yale University may nominate 1 candidate.

PURPOSE

Founded in 1988 by internationally known tenor Jose Carreras, the Foundation supports research into the diagnosis, prevention, and cure of leukemia and related hematological malignancies. The program is aimed at strengthening the research capabilities of young and promising researchers with world-wide leading senior investigators acting as project sponsors.

ELIGIBILITY

- Candidates must hold an MD, PhD, or ScD degree.
- Investigators must have completed at least 3 years of postdoctoral training, but must be less than 10 years beyond receipt of their first doctoral degree when the award begins in 2012.
- No citizenship restrictions.
- Grantees must devote at least 60% of professional time to the proposed project.
