#### FUNDING

\$30,000 per year for 2 years. (Total: \$60,000)

#### NOMINATION LIMITATION

Yale University may nominate one candidate for each award.

#### PURPOSE

The Foundation generally funds human research in the fields of childhood and adolescent depression and childhood and adolescent ADHD, but is willing to consider translational studies conducted in animals provided there is clear and demonstrable relevance to human populations.

In particular, the Foundation is interested in two-year research projects that could lead to larger projects worthy of federal funding and other national research awards. Applications are judged on originality, soundness, contributions to progress within the field, and the quality of institutional support and of the mentoring and training plan, among other factors.

#### ELIGIBILITY

- Nominees must be post-doctoral investigators holding a PhD and/or MD who have also completed all clinical training. As a general rule, nominated candidates should be at the junior faculty level, although the Foundation will consider applications nominating candidates in research training programs.
- Candidates should be planning a career in research related to child and adolescent psychiatry and have strong evidence of independent research ability.
- Fellows must be sponsored by a mentor who will be expected to monitor and lend his/her support to the fellowship, review the candidate's work, and report on progress; the mentor must have expertise in the candidate's proposed area of research.
- Candidates who have applied for or received the K award are eligible, as are those who have not yet applied for a K award and hope to use a KTGF fellowship as a stepping stone to a K award or other funding. Candidates with an R01 are not eligible.
