FUNDING

Up to \$100,000 over 2 years to cover the costs of the proposed research project. (Total: \$100,000)

If requested, funds can be used entirely in a one-year period.

NOMINATION LIMITATION

Yale University may nominate one candidate.

PURPOSE

The Foundation's focus is on funding innovative translational research in ovarian, uterine, breast or cervical cancer. Translational research is broadly defined as research that will provide a scientific link between laboratory research and the clinic. Ultimately, such research would lead to improvement in diagnosis, prognosis, prevention, or treatment of the cancer.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to all **junior and senior faculty** members.
- U.S. citizenship is not required.
- Time required to be devoted to research: not restricted.
