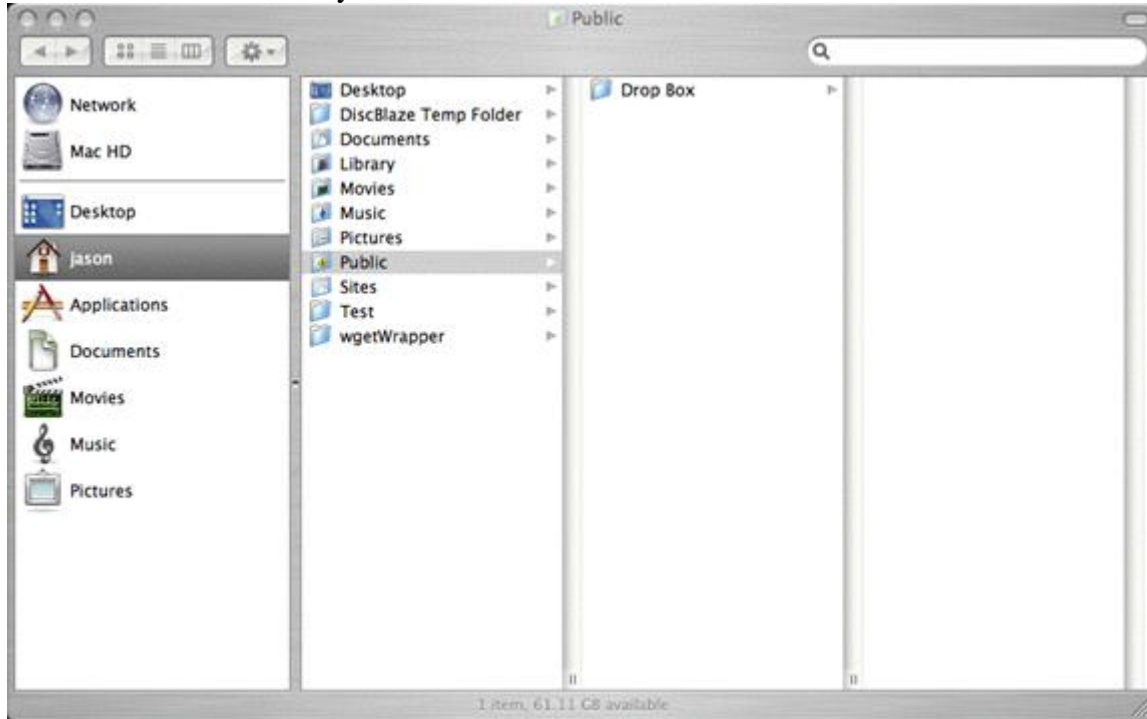




Sharing Files with Mac OS 10.4

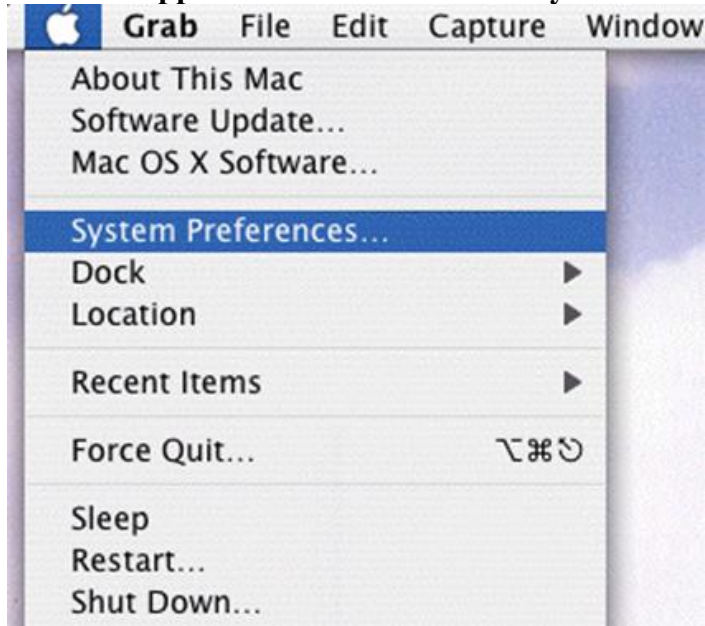
This document will help you configure your Mac OS 10.4 computer to share files securely with other Mac computers.

Place the files to share in your **Public Folder**.



Enabling AppleTalk Protocol:

Go to the **Apple Menu Items** and select **System Preferences**.

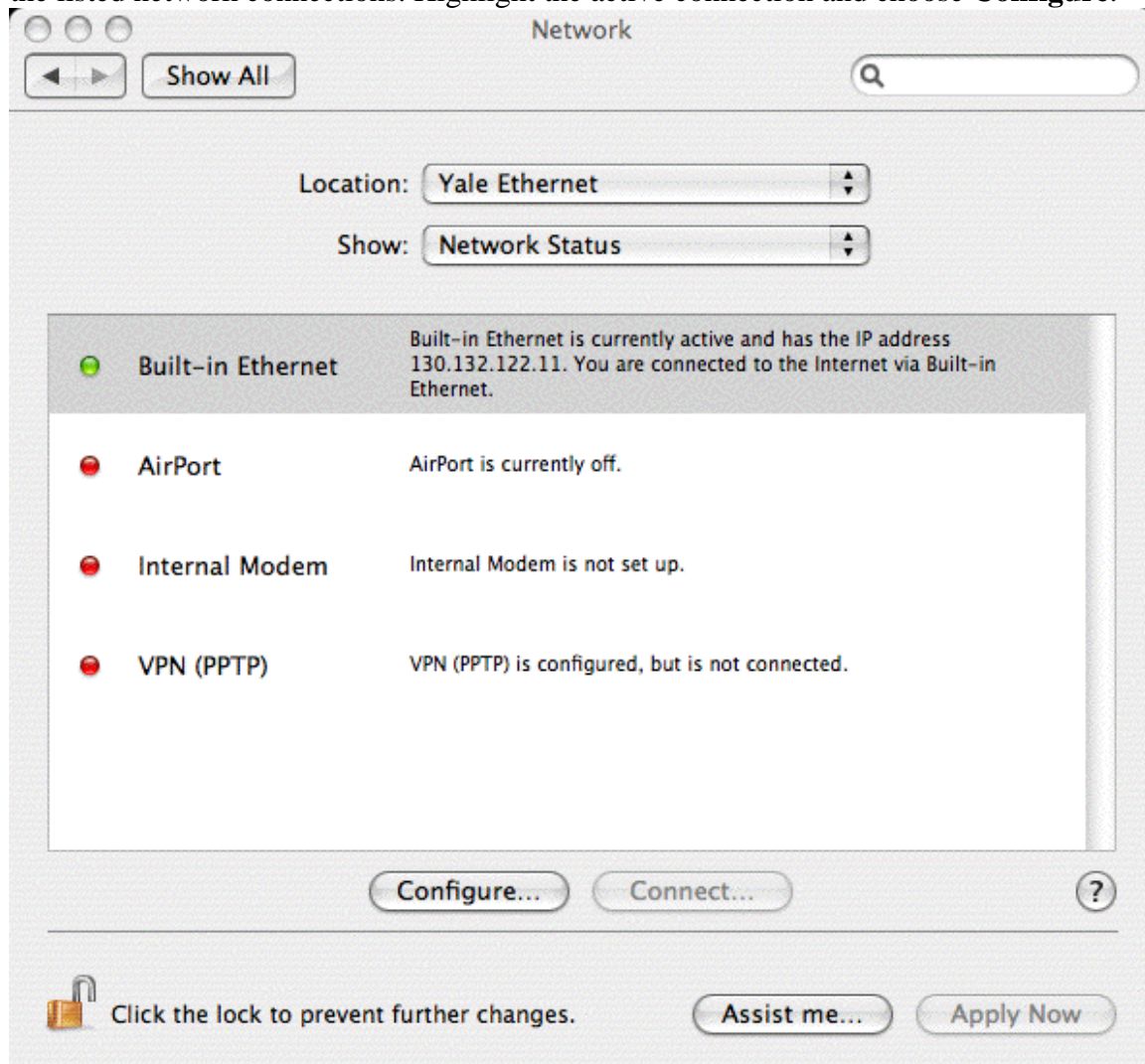


This will open the **System Preferences** window pictured below.

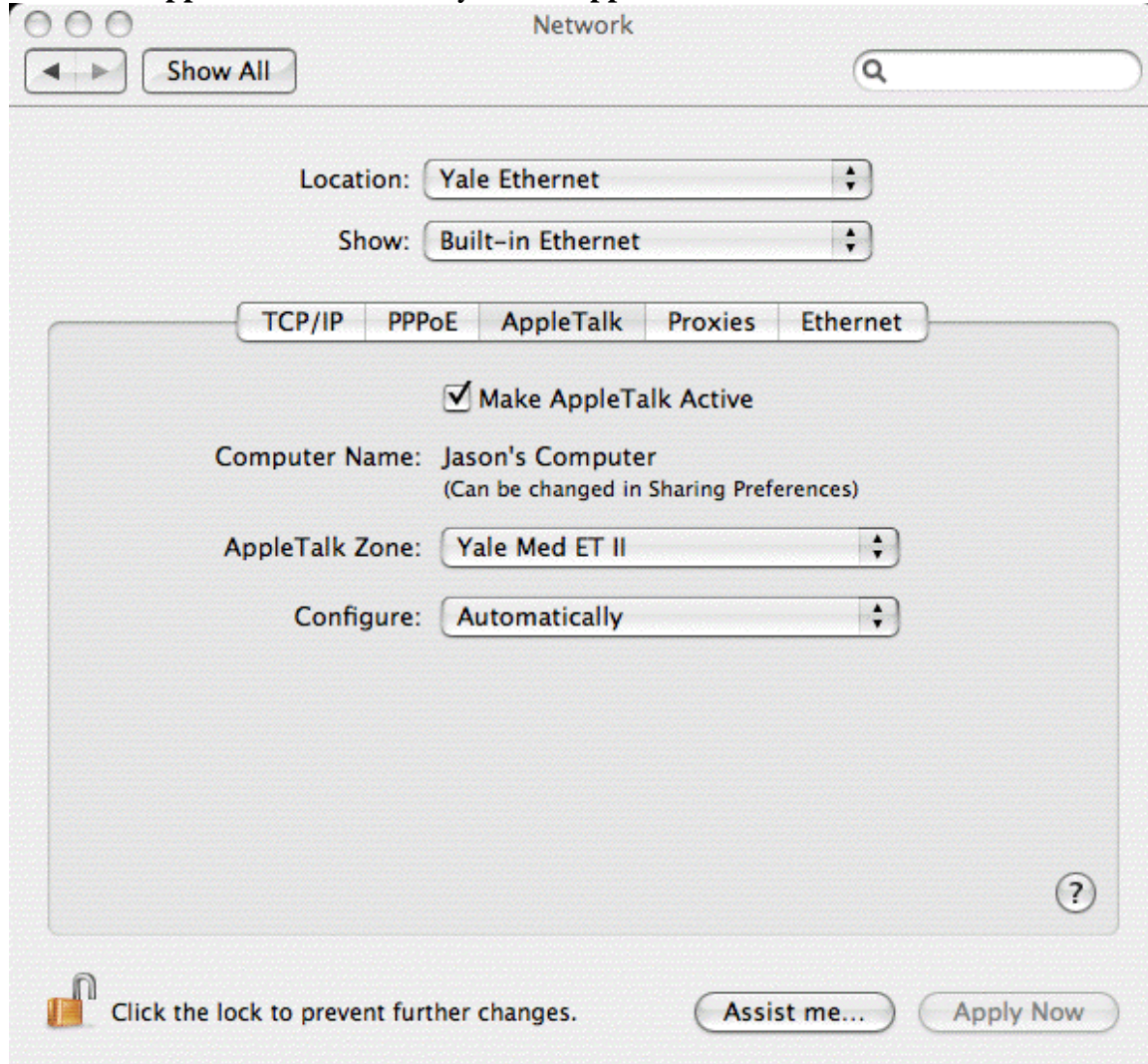


Select the **Network** icon.

Once open, select the **active Network connection**, this will be displayed with a green circle to the left of the listed network connections. Highlight the active connection and choose **Configure**.



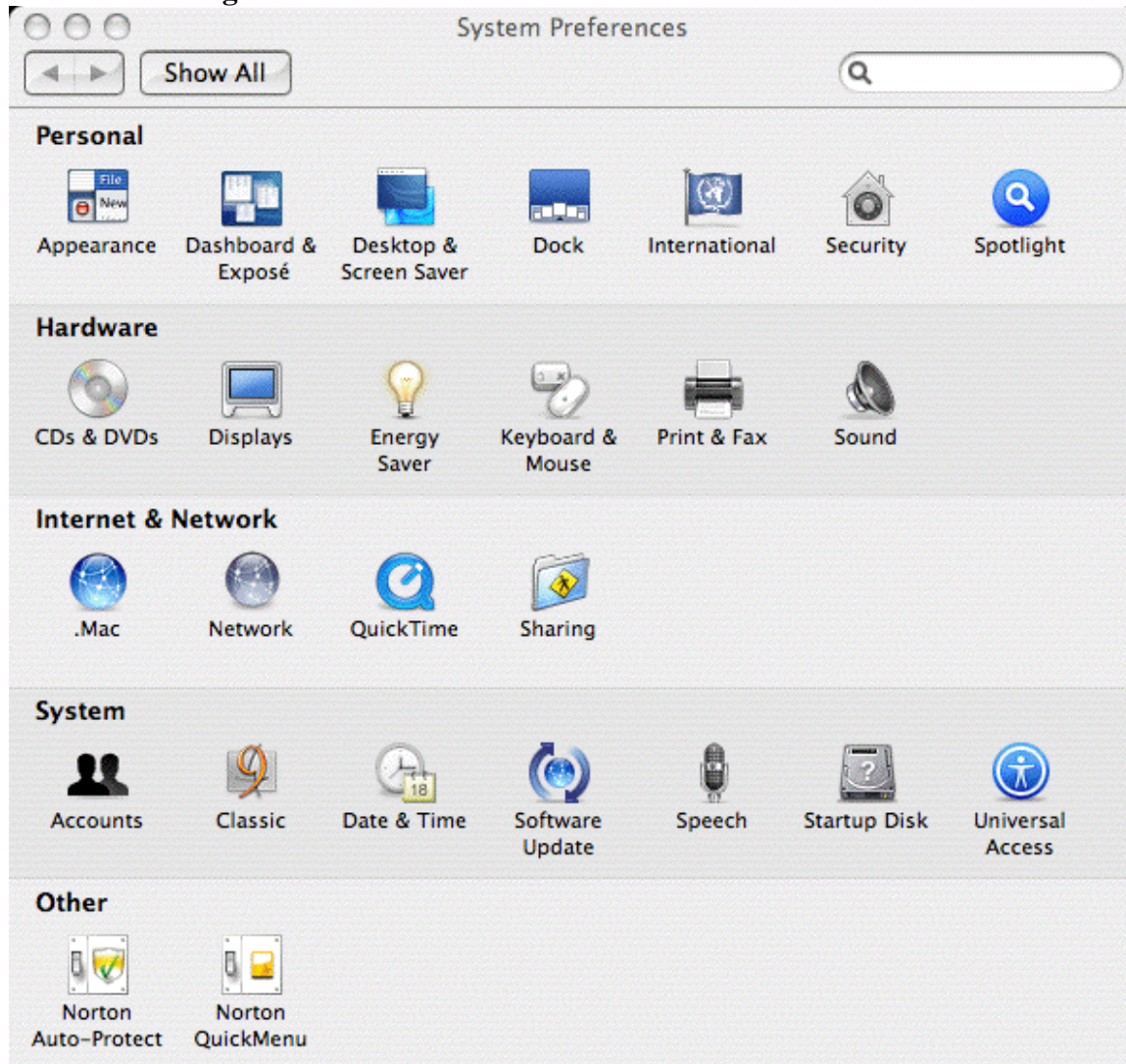
Select the **AppleTalk** tab and verify **Make AppleTalk Active** checkbox is checked. Click **Apply Now**.



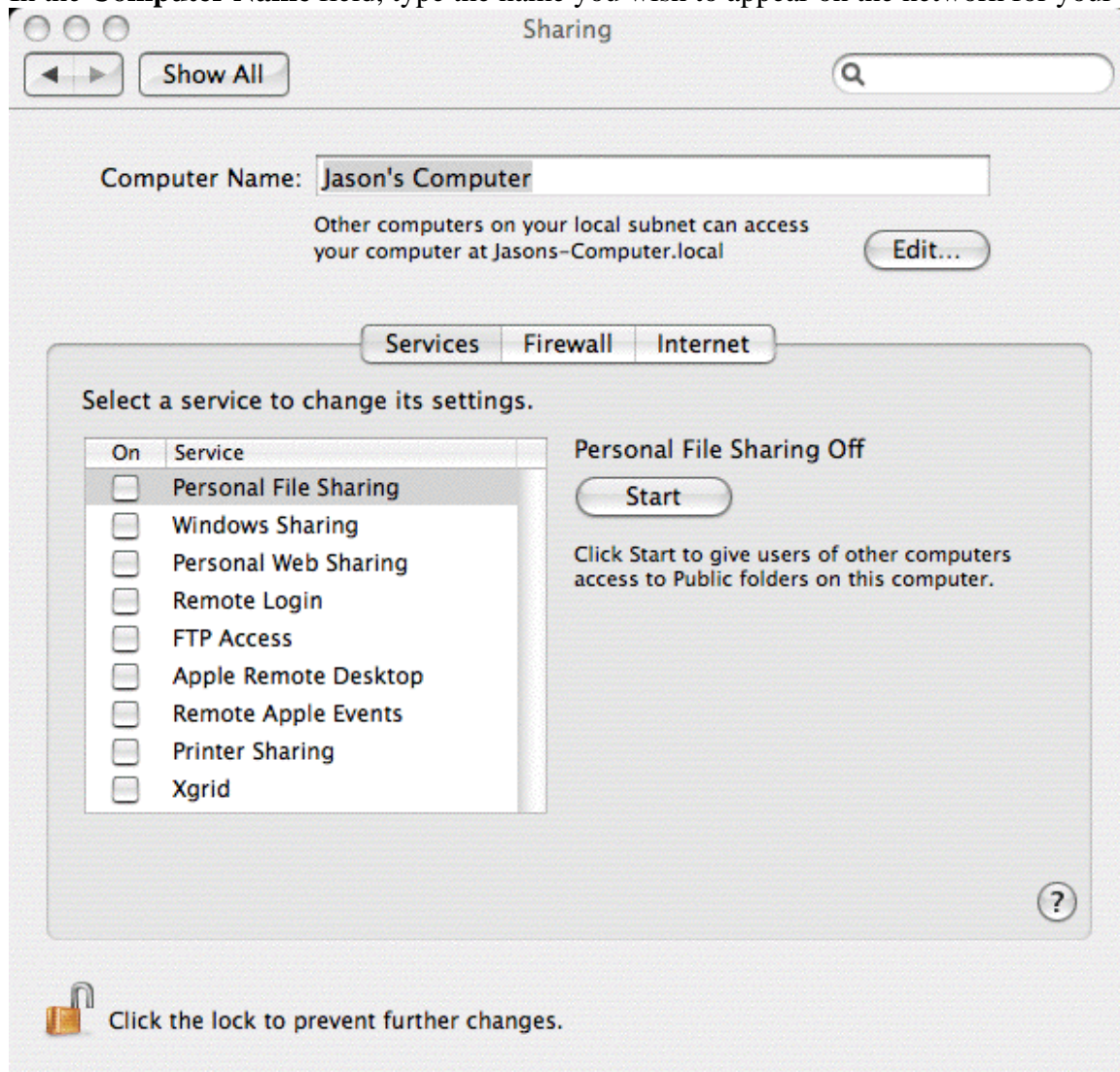
Enabling Personal File Sharing:

Click the **Show All** icon in upper left corner.

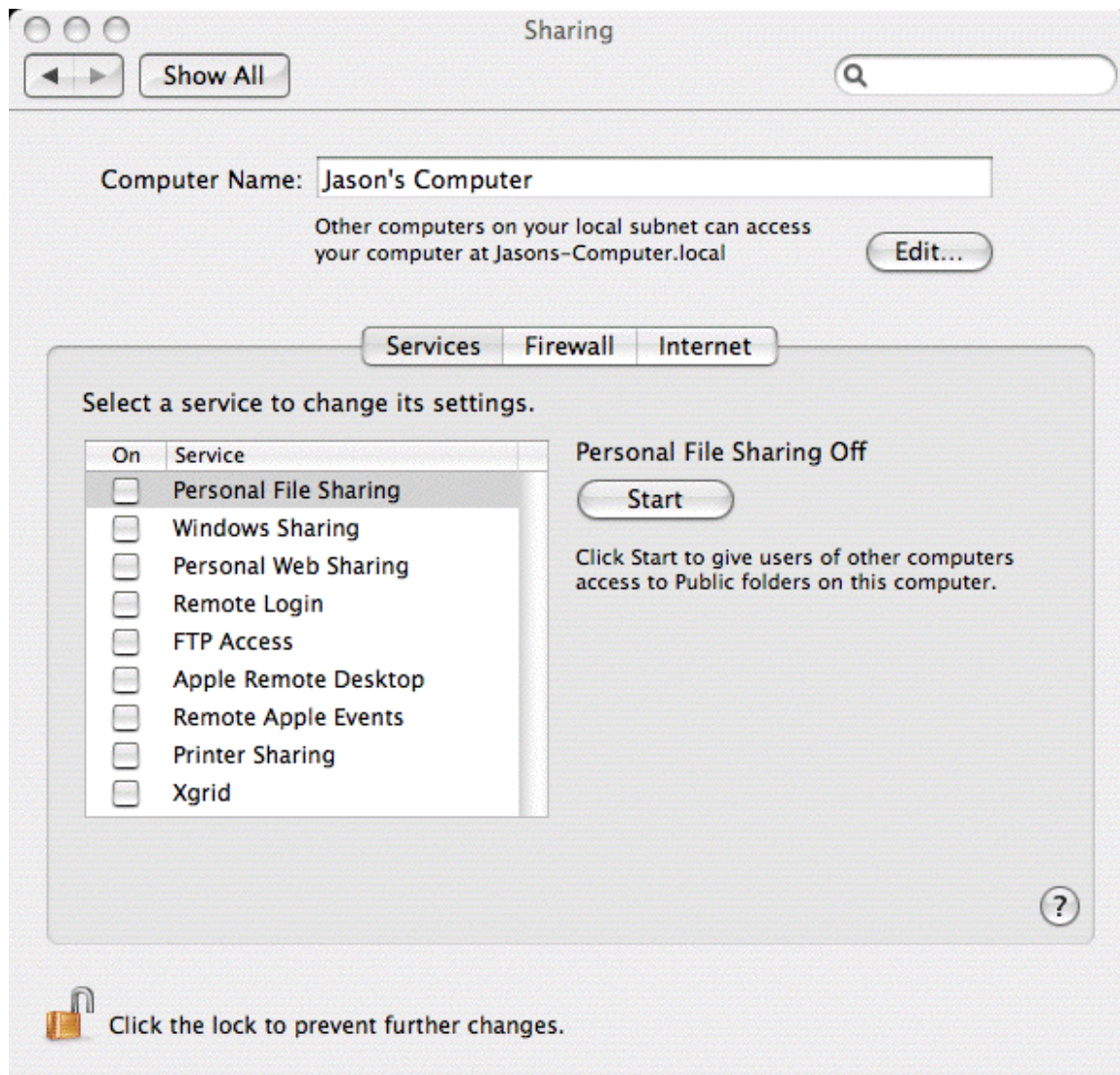
Click the **Sharing** icon.



In the **Computer Name** field, type the name you wish to appear on the network for your computer.



Click the **Start** button to turn on **Personal File Sharing** (if it has not already started).



Repeat this process on any other Mac OSX computer that you wish to receive File Sharing connections.
