



15th Annual Haitian Summer Institute

Location: FIU Modesto A. Maidique Campus, Miami, Florida

Dates: July 2-August 10, 2012

Program Summary: Now entering its 15th year, the **FIU Latin American and Caribbean Center's Haitian Summer Institute** is a 6-week program designed for anyone interested in acquiring basic conversational proficiency in Haitian Creole and also for those students who wish to continue their Haitian Creole Language training at the intermediate and advanced levels. Participants are introduced to Haitian history and culture through lectures in English and Haitian Creole presented by nationally-recognized Haitianists and Diasporic leaders, film, technical training sessions and tours of Miami's Little Haiti neighborhood.

The intensive program is divided into two parts and students have two enrollment options: Accelerated Beginning Haitian Creole for the first three weeks and Accelerated Intermediate Haitian Creole for the final three weeks, or, Accelerated Intermediate Haitian Creole for the first three weeks and Accelerated Advanced Haitian Creole for the final three weeks. Classes are held Monday through Friday and include a morning and afternoon session. Housing is available on campus at an additional cost.
