Notes:

(a) Each student, whether full-time or part-time, is counted as one student in this table. Counts for the Graduate School exclude students on leave of absence and students registered as "dissertation submission." The professional school counts exclude students on leave of absence and, prior to 2005-06, also excluded students registered in absentia paying tuition. Beginning 2005-06 the Law School counts exclude visiting scholars. The enrollment figures for each school include only those students paying tuition to that school in the Fall term. Students enrolled in Ph.D. programs affiliated with the professional schools (e.g., Medicine, Law, etc.) are counted in the Graduate School.

(b) Beginning Fall 2002, the B.L.S. degree is no longer offered to students.

(c) In April 2000, the Yale Corporation voted to approve the creation of two new degree programs: Master of Environmental Science (M.E.Sc.) and Master of Environmental Management(M.E.M.). The M.E.M.program will replace the Master of Environmental Studies (M.E.S.) program.

(d) Effective Fall 2003, the D.F.E.S. degree program has merged with the Ph.D. program in Forestry.

(e) Beginning Fall 2005, visiting scholars in the Yale Law School are no longer included in the enrollments.

(f) In September, 1998, the faculty of the School of Management voted to change the name of the degree from Master of Public & Policy Management (M.P.P.M.) to Master of Business Administration (M.B.A.). Students enrolled prior to this change will have the option of receiving either an M.P.P.M. or an M.B.A. All new students will be enrolled in the M.B.A. program.

(g) The School of Medicine discontinued the Dr. of Public Health program effective Fall, 1999. Current students will be allowed to continue in the program but no new students will be admitted.

(h) Effective August, 1999, the program was changed from a Certificate in Primary Care to a Master of Medical Science.

(i) Bachelor of Arts/Master of Music (BA/MM) students are not included in enrollment totals.

(j) Students in the D.M.A. program are non-resident students enrolled less than half-time and, with the exception of 2005-06, are not included in enrollment and are listed in brackets for information only.

(k) As a result of Hurricane Katrina, 24 displaced students were enrolled in Yale schools for the Fall 2005 semester. These "special" students were enrolled in the following schools:

Yale College - 11; Graduate School of Arts & Sciences - 6; Drama School - 2; Law School - 2; School of Medicine, Epidemiology & Public Health - 3.

(l) Effective Fall 2006, the D.N.Sc. program will be phased out and a new Ph.D. program in Nursing will be offered. Current students may remain in the program to complete their degree or transfer to the Ph.D. program. All new students will be admitted to the Ph.D. program.
