Notes:

(a) This table reports students (people counts) as opposed to the number of degrees earned. Joint degree students are counted only once. They are counted in the School where the joint degree is specified in this table. However, joint degree students in the J.D./Ph.D. and M.D./Ph.D. programs, for example, almost always finish the Professional School degrees before the Ph.D. degree. Therefore, those students will be reported only in the Professional School degree programs in a given year, and reported later in the Graduate School Ph.D. program in the year that they complete their doctoral program. Because of the difficulty in the Schools knowing and keeping records on joint-degree students who finish both degrees in the same year (possibly one student a year), those students are likely to be counted twice in this table.

Figures for Yale College do not match the numbers of students in each graduating class since some students do not receive their degrees until several years later.

The number of Terminal Master's degrees includes Graduate School students only. Yale College students earning the simultaneous BA/MA or BS/MS degree are not included.

(b) Students studying in the Institute of Sacred Music are awarded their degrees by the Divinity School or the School of Music. The counts for the Institute of Sacred Music are included in the totals above and are shown in italics for information only.

(c) Beginning in the Fall of 1993, students were admitted to the D.F.&E.S. (Doctor of Forestry & Environmental Studies) program. Students are no longer being admitted to the Doctor of Forestry program and degrees reported here represent students who were already enrolled in the program prior to its termination. Beginning Fall 2003, the D.F.&E.S. program was merged with the Ph.D. program. In April, 2000, the Yale Corporation voted to approve the creation of two new degree programs: Master of Environmental Science (M.E.Sc.) and Master of Environmental Management (M.E.M.). The M.E.M. program will replace the Master of Environmental Studies (M.E.S.) program.

(d) In September, 1998, the faculty of SOM voted to change the name of the degree from MPPM to an MBA. Current students will have the option of receiving either an MPPM or an MBA. All students entering SOM beginning in 1999 will be awarded the MBA degree.

(e) In January 2006 the Yale Corporation approved establishment of the joint M.D.-Master of Health Science degree for students completing a competitively funded full fifth year of research and other requirements.

(f) There are three options in program length in the M.P.H. program. Depending on your prior educational training, the program may take 1, 1-1/2 or 2 years. For example, it may take a physician enrolled in the program one year, and a college graduate two years to finish.

(g) Effective 1999-00, students completing the program receive the Master of Medical Science degree. Prior to this time a Certificate in Primary Care was awarded.

(h) The Doctor of Nursing Science program enrolled students for the first time in Fall of 1994. Effective Fall 2006, YSN is offering a Ph.D. in Nursing and phasing out the Doctor of Nursing Science program.
