	This reference table shows the number of degrees awarded with general honors within each of the areas of study for the entire Class of 2008. It may be a good source of reference when reading Tables 4 and 5.
<b>Table 3</b>	<b>Distribution of Graduates by Undergraduate Major</b>
	This reference table reports the areas in which the graduates of the entire Class of 2008 majored. It includes comparisons with the Classes of 2006, 2004, and 2002. It may be a good source of reference when reading Table 4.
<b>Table 4.a.</b>	<b>Post-Graduation Activities by Undergraduate Major Group</b>
	This table is based on survey data and presents the activities reported by the Class of 2008 during the 2008-09 academic year summarized by undergraduate major groups.
<b>Table 4.b.</b>	<b>Post-Graduation Activities by Yale College Major</b>
	This table is based on survey data and presents the activities reported by the Class of 2008 during the 2008-09 academic year summarized by undergraduate major.
<b>Table 5</b>	<b>Post-Graduation Activities by Graduate Standing (Honors)</b>
	This table is based on survey data and presents the activities reported by the Class of 2008 during the 2008-09 academic year by the graduate standing of the respondents (i.e., whether or not they graduated with honors).
<b>Table 6</b>	<b>Graduate and Professional Schools Chosen</b>
	This table is based on survey data and reports the graduate and professional schools chosen by the graduates who enrolled in graduate study during the 2008-09 academic year. It includes comparisons with the Classes of 2006, 2004, and 2002.
<b>Table 7</b>	<b>1960-2008 Overall Summary of Activities</b>
	This table summarizes the major areas of post-graduation activities, going back to the Class of 1960.
<b>Table 8</b>	<b>1968-2008 Graduate Study Chosen</b>
	For those class members who attended graduate or professional school the year following graduation, this table summarizes the area of study in which graduates were currently enrolled.
<b>Table 9</b>	<b>1968-2008 Employment Chosen</b>
	For those class members who were employed the year following graduation, this table summarizes the areas of employment in which graduates were currently engaged.
