Applicants are all people who submitted complete applications.

Following IPEDS definitions, resident aliens who are not citizens/nationals of the U.S. but have been lawfully admitted for permanent residence are not counted as international. Canadians are counted as international.

(a) In April 2000, the Yale Corporation voted to approve the creation of two new degree programs: Master of Environmental Science (M.E.Sc.) and Master of Environmental Management (M.E.M.). The M.E.M. program will replace the Master of Environmental Studies (M.E.S.) program.

(b) Effective 2003-04, the D.F.E.S. program is merged with the Ph.D. program. New students will be admitted to the Ph.D. program.

(c) The Dr. P.H. program was discontinued and new students were not accepted effective Fall 1999.

(d) The decline in applications is due to significant changes in the program's admissions criteria; the application deadline was moved from January up to September; a cumulative science GPA of 3.0 is required; and all pre-requisite coursework must be completed prior to application.

(e) The large increase in applications is the result of a \$100M gift to the School of Music which allows the school to fully subsidize the tuition for all students.

(f) Beginning Fall 2006 a PhD in Nursing is being offered and the D.N.S. program being phased out.
