Through its Bureau of Correctional Health Services, the Agency provides comprehensive medical and mental health care to persons incarcerated in the City's correctional facilities.

The Assistant Commissioner for Correctional Health Services will report to the Deputy Commissioner of the Division of Health Care Access and Improvement, and will be responsible for strategic planning, overseeing the day-to-day operations of the bureau, supervising approximately 175 staff and managing \$165 million in annual City funding for both direct service and contracts. The preferred candidate must be a strong administrator with experience managing health care, contracts, and inter-agency activities; comfortable working in a correctional setting; strong organizational and leadership abilities and a minimum of 5 years of administrative and supervisory experience.
